A joint OCRA/DFMA sponsored program by NASA is being offered on Monday, August 12th at 7:30pm. This, *twice postponed*, NASA presentation will be on the Zoom video platform with details to be published later.

There will actually be two presentations. One of the speakers will be Al Feinberg, the Strategic Content and Media Advisor for NASA Space Communications & NASA Television Headquarters in Washington, D.C. His presentation will be on "Space Communications in Support of NASA."

The other speaker is Rosalie White, K1STO, ARRISS (Amateur Radio on the International Space Station) US Delegate. Her presentation will be "Celebrating 20 Years of Continuous Amateur Radio Operations on the ISS."

Some of you may remember the space station communication from the Phillips

Middle School in Chapel Hill. That happened almost 20 years ago and was quite a media event. The teacher of the class involved, Barbara Pederson, KE4JZM, had an HF station in her classroom. (Barbara was also active in the Civil Air Patrol.)

DFMA Board Meeting Minutes for General Release to the Membership – 06/15/2021– Dan KR4UB, Secretary

President - Jack called the meeting to order at 7pm with the call for officer reports.

Officer Reports

President - Jack reported work is underway for the newly adopted DFMA Code of Conduct to be posted on the website.

Club Secretary - Dan, KR4UB Nothing to report other than calling for a vote of approval for the 6/1/21 club meeting and 5/18/21 Board minutes.

Treasurer's Report - Lenore, KF4PAB provided the treasurer's report that 95 member's dues are current.

Club Treasury Balances: were reported.

Repeater Manager - Charlie, NC4CD unable to attend. Paul reported the crystals to change the frequency will not arrive until some time in July as the special request made for high temperature stability performance requires a long term burn-in and stability checking over a considerable length of time.

Discussion Items:

Jack and Lenore asked Dan a number of questions about the postponed NASA Meeting.

- Dan responded that with Field Day planned activities and ongoing discussions with the overall feeling that July is too soon to meet, and that August would be the most probable target to reschedule the presentation.
- Where would the combined meeting for the presentation be? Dan responded that with late cancellation and Field Day upon us there are no plans at this point. Lenore asked about the seating capacity at the Efland Baha'i center. It is a large capacity meeting room that could hold both club's members and has a large screen HDTV available for presentations.
- Dan summarized the responses to a set of poll questions asked at the last OCRA meeting as follows:

How many will attend the rescheduled NASA presentation as a future meeting?

- Of the 26 ultimately present at the meeting (2 late arrivals missed the poll) Close to 100% (23) stated they will attend the rescheduled NASA presentation.
- Given the late breaking (day of the event cancellation) two methods were used to notify attendees.
 - + direct mailing of members or
 - + posting on groups.io. What is the preferred, best way?
- 14 preferred exclusive direct mailing notification (in this case from the OCRA mass emailer the NASA cancellation).

- 9 stated they received the direct mailing and some number of those also received a groups.io email notification of the posted cancellation notice.
- In the discussion it came apparent that notification effectiveness for late breaking events via groups.io could be problematic given the various options settable by groups.io members. Notifications can be set by members ranging from individual immediate notification, once a day digest (of the previous day postings sent the morning of the next day), or no email notification (thus reliance on checking the groups.io web posts for any late breaking messages).

Regarding DurHamFest, Dee reported that conversation with the Durham Public Schools liaison contact is that a target to re-open the facility has not been set. There is considerable in-house demand that may preclude the possibility of the facility being available for outside group use.

DFMA Annual August Elections - Jack gave the following synopsis of the upcoming elections.

- President Lenore, KF4PAB is running for president; no other candidates have come forward.
- Vice President No candidates have come forward for vice president.
- Treasurer Jack is running for treasurer; no other candidates have come forward.
- Secretary No one is running for secretary.
- Repeater Manager Charlie is willing to continue as DFMA repeater manager.
- There are two At-Large 2 year positions open with 3 candidates Dan, KR4UB, Paul, N2XZF and Bob, K4VO.

Bob, K4VO asked about the Board At-Large open positions.

- Dee replied there are 4 board at-large positions with 2 year terms that 2 positions come open bi annually.
- Dan replied that he would really like to see Bob become a member of the at-large board and that he would be willing to step down from the at-large position.
- Dee expressed concern about losing the expertise of past board members and an option would be to have more appointed positions to keep past officers and board members involved in roles such as assistant treasurers, assistant secretaries or repeater support committee.

• In that light, Dan offered that given the past extensive assistance Charlie NC4CD and Paul, N2ZXF have given with OCRA repeaters, he is more than willing to join the DFMA repeater committee and return the favor to DFMA. He would also be willing to assist the new secretary in the same manner Dee has done from the beginning of Dan's term in 2014 and continuing to this day. He has provided great assistance in proof reading and making suggestions to draft minutes.

Bob also suggested that the board meetings by video conference would have to continue for him to be a board member. Lenore and Dan responded strongly suggesting continuation of board video conference meetings format and could make it more attractive for new members to join the board.

All board members were given the challenge to think of who to aggressively recruit for the open positions. A number of suggestions were made pointing out members with regular attendance at the DFMA club meetings.

Next Jack called for a motion of approval of the May 18th board and June 1st club net minutes, which were approved by unanimous vote.

Next topic was the time frame to re-open regular club meetings at Bullock's BBQ. Jack summarized the membership survey results on re-opening. 27 members responded with 21 indicating they would attend an August meeting. Only 3 indicated they could not attend an August meeting. Other options regarding vaccination status were discussed. An interim July picnic meeting was discussed, but with Field Day upon us and lead time required pretty much rules out that opportunity. The July club meeting will continue as an on-the-air meeting as done for the past year. Elections will be held at the August club meeting at Bullock's and there may be some provision for internet voting for those who can't attend. Late breaking news regarding Covid-19 variants from area health directors suggests that members not vaccinated possibly due to health issues and those electing to not be vaccinated should not attend the meeting, since wearing masks and eating at the same time are not possible.

Bob suggested and Jack led a discussion on the possibility of a video conference connection for those who can't attend. Internet connectivity at Bullock's, alternatives, how to do a quality job, would there be sufficient remote participation and interest to justify came up. The conversation ended with the

perspective that this could be a possibility but more work to determine sufficient interest exists to justify the effort.

In the end Dee summarized that showing intent, some experiments to learn, whether long term interest justifies considering proceeding, would be the best path to address the question.

A motion was made and passed to **adjourn the meeting at 9:30pm**

President - Jack, KM4MBG opened the DFMA club over-the-air meeting net at 7 pm with check-ins and called for brief officer reports, announcements, followed by a rag chew session.

Secretary – Dan, KR4UB nothing to report as secretary.

Repeater Manager – Charlie, NC4CD Nothing new to report.

Jack, KM4MBG began the announcements portion of the meeting that DFMA will be resuming in-person events on Tuesday, August 3rd with the general membership meeting beginning at 7pm at Bullock's BBQ restaurant in Durham. Many people arrive around 6pm to eat and socialize before the meeting begins.

Jack is investigating the equipment needed to be able to live stream the membership meeting portion of Bullock's events for those who can not attend.

The annual DFMA elections will be held at this meeting. Jack continued by reporting the current slate of nominees as follows:

Normally Dan, KR4UB's expiring secretary term, would allow him run for the board position, as had planned but he has offered to step back to leave an uncontested position for Bob, K4VO to join the board. Dan, recounting the repeater assistance that Charlie NC4CD and Paul, N2XZF have provided to OCRA over the years, wants to volunteer to join the DFMA Repeater Committee to assist where needed in maintaining the DFMA's repeaters.

Dee reiterated the point that now is the time for all club members to give serious consideration to supporting the club, most notably in volunteering for the vacant positions noted above or consider helping as an assistant to one of the positions. The assistant concept would be for additional club members, past officers & board members to help with roles for example, the vice president in securing club presentations for club meetings. Knowing that there would be a larger team contributing to fulfilling a specific officer role, might help in getting more members to volunteer to take on the officer position.

Dee's next topic was the 2021 DFMA Directory. The last DFMA directory was distributed at the 2019 DurHamFest. All club members whose directory information has changed since the last directory should complete the membership form available on the club website (and also attached with the last email distribution of the DFMA Newsletter) to provide their current information.

KR4UB, Dan commented that the up front work to get the N1MM logging software setup really helped out during his FT4 and FT8 Field Day operations, helping him make more contacts and easy export of the Cabrillo log for submission to the ARRL.
