### **Door Prizes are Back!**

### Minutes approval

### Repeater Manager

A request was made for machine readable reimbursement forms.

### **Membership Chair**

97 Members

In recent years we have only distributed the directory in-person, but do we want to mail it this year? Since the last time we mailed it, the postage cost has gone up. Estimated cost to be  $\sim$ \$100. Plus there will be labor.

Decision about mailing postponed until we know about more the future of in-person meetings.

Discussion on whether we could send people an electronic copy. Many, many years ago, it was agreed [secretarial note: it would be great if we could find a reference to this agreement] that machine readable directories would not be produced.

No objections were raised to the new membership form.

### **Next in-person meeting**

Are the COVID numbers looking better? Are we willing to try it? Can we find a different venue? Feelings seem to be split.

Why aren't people coming to the meetings? Should we have programs for the virtual meetings? We postponed our August presenter? Should we get feedback from the members?

One alternative meeting location would be local churches if we had contacts there and they rent out their space.

It doesn't sound like we're going to do in-person in September. Therefore we probably want to mail directories and ask the membership about digital directories.

What do we want to do the virtual meeting? Do we want a presentation? Maybe we can poach a RARS presenter? Yes. Bob will ask K4RGN to give September presentation on RF safety as well as a few other folks.

The Vice President shouldn't be solely responsible for meetings. Can instead act as coordinator/organizer for the ideas and people doing recruiting. Should put something in the Link about this. Charlie volunted to write something along these lines for the Link.

Do we have ideas of who can be Vice President? Did we ask anyone in the past? We did ask one person, but they didn't respond. Lenore will ask Sam, KJ4VWG.

### Plans for the next year

### - Revise Bylaws (Lenore)

We don't think we have a copy of the latest version with the quorum reduction. The newest version that we have doesn't match our current practices. January proposed for a deadline to vote on the revision.

#### - Retire MCU (Bob)

Retire MCU and transfer equipment into something simpler/cheaper/easier to maintain and transport.
