Approval of Minutes

REPORTS.

Treasurer. Jack is working on

transitioning into the office of Treasurer. No changes in checking and CD balances since last report. Paperwork is being done with our Bank of America accounts to add Jack to the signature list for the accounts.

Repeater Manager. AllStar hardware has been installed at Hillsborough to enable linking of our 224.26 repeater to the Virginia 220 Linked System. Adriano will be putting it on the air this week. The TV Hill 6 meter repeater has been moved from 53.63 MHz. to 53.61 MHz. and is on the air and working ok.

Durhamfest. Dee will be talking with the Durham School reps to determine if they will let us rent the Hillandale School site for the 2022 Durhamfest RARS has cancelled their 2022 RARS Fest.

MAIN TOPICS.

Possum Trot Net. The PT Net is now down to one net control station, Derwin, KN4KUO, after the passing of George Sackett, KA4MRN, on September 4. Derwin will be on vacation starting September 25 so the status of the net is undetermined. The PT Net has been held on DFMA 147.225 and 145.45 repeaters for many years. It is not an official DFMA function. DFMA provides the repeaters for the net. Net controls are not necessarily DFMA members and DFMA is not responsible for scheduling net control operators.

Officers. Vice President and Secretary. After the recent election of officers, DFMA still does not have a secretary or vice president. Several members have been asked to serve in one of these offices but no one has agreed to do so. A new member, Bob Shelton, KO4SZE, was asked by

Lenore if he would be willing to serve as Secretary. He will discuss the job with Lenore after the meeting.

Upcoming Meetings. The October meeting will be virtual due to COVID concerns. Tad, KA2DEW, is scheduled to give a program on his visit to Houston

to observe a Space X launch. Board meetings will continue to be held virtually. Dee said that he wanted to resume door prizes at DFMA meetings. He suggested a \$20 gift certificate to Bullock's BBQ for members and a year's free membership in DFMA for nonmembers.
