The Carolina 440 Repeater System

Ronnie, K4JDR, has built and maintains the Carolina 440 Repeater System. Currently the system has 18 repeaters between

Burlington and the North Carolina Outer Banks. Many of the repeaters are linked by radio and have internet linking capabilities. One of the repeaters in the system is on 444.925 and is located on the Durham 911 tower near Camden Avenue. John Lemay, KB4WGA, a former DFMA member, built that repeater and passed it on to Ronnie when he moved to Tampa. The Carolina 440 system is used for many public service events because of its wide area coverage with linked repeaters. Ronnie has IRLP, Echo Link, AllStar, and other technologies available in the system. Check out his web site, www.carolina440.net before the meeting to learn more and be ready to hear all about it.

Until his retirement a few years ago, Ronnie worked for the Cary Fire Department and was heavily involved with the Department's radio systems. Ronnie is assisted in the maintenance and construction of the system by Butch, KF4AUF, who will be participating in the program with Ronnie.

DFMA Elections in August

The August meeting is only three weeks away, but it's not too late to run for a DFMA office or serve as an At Large DFMA Board member. The DFMA Board of Directors (the Board) consists of five officers (President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and

Repeater Manager) and four At Large Board Members. Officers serve for one year terms while At Large members serve for two year terms. In the DFMA, all official work is done by the Board. Sometimes the Board will submit decisions for membership approval, such as spending for large ticket items. The individual member elects the Board and then the Board is expected to represent the interest of the members. So, if you want to be involved in the DFMA decision making you need to run for a position.

While some of the present officers have agreed to run for reelection, there's no reason there can't be more than one candidate per slot. So, if you would like to

be part of the fun, run! (and not away!!!)

The DFMA also has other positions that are technically not Board Members which are appointed by the Board, rather than elected. These include the editor of The Link (our newsletter), Webmaster, Field Day Coordinator and Net Manager. A fairly new innovation is to appoint assistants to the officers. So, we currently have an Assistant Repeater Manager, Paul N2XZF. So, if you are interested in any of these positions, let any Board member know. (The appointments to these positions can be made at any time since they do not involve the election in August.)

So, get involved! We need your help! You can send email to ku4gc@amsat.org if interested.

Technicalities: If you decide to run for an office, please let me know by email

(ku4gc@amsat.org). This is not a requirement (you can be nominated from the floor at the time of the actual election), but I'll see that you are listed in the August Link as one of the candidates. It will also let us know if we need paper ballots. (People running unopposed are usually elected by unanimous consent.)
