## Terry Rogers, WA4BVY, SK



Another ham friend has left us. Terry became a serious ham in his high school days, having been given a good start by an Elmer who nudged him to build a nice big triode amplifier to go with his Heathkit starter rig. He went on to get a good technical education and work at such places as GE, Sony Ericcson, and some smaller companies too. His contributions spanned the fields of communications radio, large scale video screens, mobile phones, and high power plasma generation. He knew his electronic fundamentals and was adept at applying them to whatever problems he encountered and he was always available to help those with whom he worked.

Terry served in the MP's and in communications, in Vietnam, where he received a purple heart. Being a skilled ham, he was able to contribute to both operation and maintenance of several kinds of radio equipment in use in the field.

Some of you may remember his bringing his wife, Sharon, to DFMA meetings. Sharon died several years ago and Terry remarried. His new wife, Robin Rogers, cared for him as he fought a battle with metastatic prostate cancer. He maintained a positive attitude until he died, telling people not to be sad that he was passing, rather that he knew he had had 82 good years and appreciated the time he had with us.

I saw Terry about two weeks ago, when he told me he expected to live until Christmas. Although that didn't happen, I am glad I got a last visit and the chance to chat about electronics and life. He was sharp until the end, telling me details of his latest switching power supply design.

Terry wanted no services. There will be a private graveside gathering of family, but nothing else. Robin will remain at their home in Durham. If anyone wishes to send condolences, I will be happy to get them to her.
