
President's Korner

Fun Time at the August DFMA Meeting


Bobby W4FK introduced a new game for the door prizes called "Porch pirate door prize pursuit".

Paul N2XZF was drawn as the Pirate and donned a Pirate Hat!.





Held at Bullock's BBQ, Durham NC

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm.

Member Introductions.

President - Bobby W4FK

OFFICER REPORTS

Vice President -Matthew KQ4ZYW – Working on getting presentations lined up. Next month might be about POTA.

Secretary Tim KC1TWR – Added a link to The Link in the monthly email he sends out with The Link pdf. He would like feedback if there were a good amount of interest in a web page version of The Link for use on cell phones. He will be working on the club Directory and warns the format may change due to different publishing software being used.

Treasurer - Wilson W4BOH – No totals given, but we have more in the bank than last month, with about \$200 income from items sold.

Repeater Manager - Charlie NC4CD
The Hillsborough repeater lost power from 11 pm to 3 am but was powered successfully by the backup generator. Now everything is back to normal.

224.26 repeater has an audio level issue he will be looking into. Charlie received two boxes of Possum Trot Net memorabilia from Wilson W4BOH and is working on a presentation possibly in October. He is looking for help from past Possum Trot Members.

Durham EOC: Charlie NC4CD reported a group will be going to the EOC next week with radios to test connecting to local repeaters and the condition of the antennas. The new EOC is at least two years out to be built. Chip KF4WBK asked how to get the Red Cross (RC) involved, and a current RC radio status was discussed. He said RC is looking for emergency communication between their offices.

Presentation: JR N4JQR talked about his DMR radio and UHF amplifier. Charlie NC4CD mentioned there is a DMR linked repeater system in NC. More info to be found at NCPRN.net.

Health and Welfare: Charlie NC4CD relayed an article about the passing of Ambrose "Tripp" L Owens N4NTO. He was erecting an antenna on July 4th, 2025, for POTA when it came into contact with a power line. He was an avid participant with POTA, activating over 660 parks. Owens was an ARRL member and belonged to the Potomac Valley Radio Club.

Show and Tell: Daniel KQ4GOB gave a review of his Tough-Book laptop. Dave NA4VY showed a small vintage microphone he found at a thrift store. Bobby W4FK showed his Baofeng K6 Tri-band HT radio.
